biscuits, the table was always full, and somebody you loved was standing there keeping an eye on the door. Those weren’t fancy days. But looking back now... They were mighty good ones.

And the older I get, the more I realize life works a lot like that old screen door. If you leave it open too long, things start getting in that don’t belong there. A little bitterness...
