I grew up hearing folks say, “Close only counts in horseshoes.” Back then, I didn’t give it much thought. It was just one of those sayings passed around like porch talk on a warm evening. But the older I get, the more I realize just how much truth is tucked in-side those simple words. There are some things in life where “close enough” will do just fine. Horseshoes, for instance—you don’t have to hit the stake dead on. Just get it close, and it counts. Same goes for a lot of everyday living. Your biscuits might not all be perfectly round, your garden rows may wander a little, and a good story might stretch just enough to make it worth telling. Most folks will smile and say, “That’s close enough.”

But then there are things where close isn’t good enough—not even a little bit. A ship can leave port just one degree off course and not look like much at all in the beginning. The water may be calm, the heading seems right, and everything feels fine. But given enough time and distance, that one small degree will carry it miles away from where it was supposed to be. What started out as “close” ends up completely off course if not adjusted. The same goes for setting the timing on an engine. “Almost right” will leave you broke down on the side of the road. Squaring a foundation is no different—if it’s off even a little, the whole house will carry that error from the ground up. That’s why folks use tools that are designed for precision such as levels, micrometers, and calipers. Because in certain situations, close isn’t acceptable.

But here’s the good news. If a ship can get off course by degrees, it can also get back on course the same way. The captain doesn’t always make one sharp, dramatic turn in the middle of the ocean. More often, it’s small adjustments—just a degree here, a degree there—until the ship is lined back up with where it needs to go. Steady corrections over time can bring you all the way home.

Life works that way too. You don’t always have to fix everything all at once. Sometimes it’s a small shift in how you speak to your spouse. A small step toward taking care of your health. A quiet moment spent with God with a brief devotion, a few scriptures, a moment of silence and reflection that turns your heart just a little closer in the right direction. Those small degrees matter more than you think.

Scripture reminds us, “Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him and He will direct thy paths.(Proverbs 3:5-6)
